NARRATIVE: The undersigned has probable cause to believe the above-named defendant on the 23 of February 2020
 at 23:12 at 4748 FRANTZ LN #3 (Zone: 24) in Orange County did

Background: On February 24, 2020, at 1301 hours, Orange County deputies responded to 4748 Frantz Lane #3, Winter Park, Florida, in reference to a female reporting that her boyfriend, Jorge Torres Jr. was deceased. The caller, later identified as Sarah Boone (DOB: 10/10/1977) reported playing a game of "hide-n-seek." Sarah and Jorge jokingly thought it would be funny if Jorge got in the suitcase located in the living room. Sarah zipped Jorge in the suitcase. Sarah mentioned that she and Jorge had been consuming alcohol during the night and she went upstairs and passed out in her bed. She later woke up to her cellphone ringing multiple times around 1100 hours. She went downstairs and did not see Jorge anywhere in the apartment, she then realized that he was possibly still inside the suitcase. Sarah unzipped the suitcase and found Jorge unresponsive and not breathing. Shortly after the 911 call, deputies arrived on scene. Orange County Fire Department confirmed that Jorge was in fact deceased at 1307 hours. The decedent was found lying near the front door of the residence near a blue suitcase. A small laceration was evident on the decedent's lip and what appeared to be some bruising around his eye. Interview Sarah Boone: On February 24, 2020, at 1657 hours, Detective Scott Lowen and I conducted an audio-recorded interview with Sarah Boone located in my unmarked agency vehicle outside of her residence located at 4748 Frantz Lane #3, Winter Park, Florida. The following is a synopsis of Sarah Boone's sworn recorded statement: I read verbatim to Sarah her constitutional Miranda warnings. Sarah agreed she understood what I had just read to her. On February 23, 2020, at approximately 1600 hours. Sarah was located at her residence, 4748 Frantz Lane #3, Winter Park, Florida, along with her boyfriend, Jorge Torres Jr. who also resides at the apartment. Only Sarah and Jorge were located at the residence. Sarah's son, Lukas Boone, would sometimes be at her residence when it was her days per the custody agreement she has with her ex-husband. Sarah said her and Jorge were painting pictures and completing a puzzle while sharing a bottle of Woodbridge Chardonnay wine. As the evening went on, Sarah said her and Jorge decided to play a game called "hide-n-seek." Sarah hid upstairs in her shower first and said Jorge never came to look for her. After a while she decided to go downstairs where she found Jorge. Sarah and Jorge both thought it would be funny if she zipped Jorge in the blue suitcase that was located downstairs in the living room area that had a few miscellaneous items they had both planned to donate. Jorge willingly got into the suitcase and Sarah zipped the suitcase up, but two of Jorge's fingers were able to stick out of the suitcase. Sarah and Jorge were both laughing that she zipped him into the suitcase. Sarah explained the attached handle that made it easier to zip the suitcase was broken but a paper clip was in the zipper and she was able to zip the suitcase up. On February 24, 2020, at approximately 0030 hours, Sarah decided she was going to go upstairs while Jorge was still located in the suitcase thinking he could get himself out. Sarah laid down in her bed and fell asleep approximately 20 to 30 minutes after going upstairs. Sarah assumed Jorge was going to get out of the suitcase and come to bed as well. Sarah said neither her nor Jorge were drunk from the wine. Sarah woke up in the morning and heard her cellphone ringing multiple times but ignored the calls. Sarah said her cellphone was left downstairs from the night prior. Sarah knew her ex-husband, Brian Boone, was calling because he was the only person who called her repeatedly to see if she was getting their son, Lukas Boone, from school. Sarah said she stayed upstairs for a while and assumed Jorge was downstairs on the laptop looking for employment. Sarah said she went downstairs at approximately 1100 hours and realized she could not find Jorge anywhere in the apartment. Sarah freaked out and remembered the last time she saw Jorge was when she zipped him in the suitcase. Sarah unzipped the suitcase and found Jorge unresponsive. Sarah called Brian back, told him Jorge was dead and begged him to come to her residence. Brian only resides a few minutes away. When Brian got to the residence he walked into the apartment, saw Jorge unresponsive on the floor and told Sarah she needed to call 911. Brian then immediately walked outside and stayed there until law enforcement arrived while Sarah followed the instructions from the 911 operator. Sarah Boone's iPhone XS: On February 24, 2020, Sarah gave verbal and written consent by signing a waivers and affidavits form for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to search her iPhone XS; IMEI: 357207096252218. Digital Forensic Investigator Junella Uadan responded to the scene and began to download the cellphone. While the cellphone was being downloaded two videos were found on the cellphone. The first video began recording on February 24, 2020, at 2312 hours. Jorge repeatedly yelling out Sarah's name. Sarah told Jorge, "For everything you've done to me. Fuck you (Sarah was laughing when she said fuck you). Stupid." Jorge repeatedly kept calling out Sarah's name. Jorge said, "I can't fucking breathe, seriously." Sarah replied, "Yeah that's what you do when you choke me." Jorge continued to repeat himself telling Sarah he could not breathe. Sarah replied, "That's on you. Oh, that's what I feel like when you cheat on me." Sarah said, "You should probably shut the fuck up." In this video the suitcase was facing downward and you can see Jorge pushing on the suitcase in an attempt to get out. The video is two (2) minutes and three (3) seconds long. The second video began recording on February 24, 2020 hours. Jorge yelled out Sarah's name. The suitcase was now in a different position facing upwards and moved over towards the left side of the living room. The

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video was 22 seconds long. Synopsis of Jorge Torres Jr. Autopsy: On February 25, 2020, Jorge Torres Jr. received an autopsy located at the medical examiner's office. During the autopsy it was noted that Jorge had injuries. Jorge had long nail scratches to his mid-upper back, a large nail scratch to the back of his neck, contusions to his left shoulder, left skull and forehead contusions considered blunt force trauma, and a cut near his busted lip. Follow-Up Interview with Sarah Boone: On February 25, 2020, at approximately 1500 hours, Sarah drove herself to the Orange County Sheriff's Office located at 2500 W. Colonial Drive, Orlando, Florida. Detective Scott Lowen and I conducted an audio and video recorded interview with Sarah. The following is a synopsis of Sarah Boone's sworn recorded statement: I read verbatim to Sarah her constitutional Miranda warnings. Sarah agreed she understood what I had just read to her. After informing Sarah about the injuries to Jorge's body, she continued to deny any physical altercation occurred between the two of them. Sarah was shown the approximate two (2) minute video that she recorded on her cellphone. Not even half way through Sarah no longer wished to watch the video. Sarah said she did not remember making the two (2) videos. Sarah said the video looked "bad." Sarah denied intentionally leaving Jorge in the suitcase. Sarah was asked why she intentionally went upstairs and waited for Jorge to come upstairs and did not check on him or let him out prior to going upstairs. Sarah replied "I don't know." Sarah contradicted her original statement and began to blame the consumption of alcohol. Sarah was informed she was not free to leave and under arrest. Deputy Sheriff Lisa Deleon responded to Central Operations to transport Sarah Boone to BRC. Based off Sarah's inconsistent statements on what occurred and the videos found on Sarah's iPhone I believe probable cause exist to charge Sarah Boone with Second Degree Murder. Jorge Torres Jr. is dead and his death was caused by Sarah Boone's criminal act. Sarah zipped Jorge in the suitcase to where he could not get out. Jorge begged Sarah repeatedly telling her he could not breathe and Sarah left him in the suitcase therefore proves the unlawful killing of Jorge by Sarah's actions that were imminently dangerous and demonstrated a depraved mind without regard for Jorge's life.
