2 1. Set Up a Safe Account

- · Use a parent-managed email for child's account
- Use a strong password, and enable
- Two-factor autthentication (FA) (or 16 in some countries per GDPR)

2. Adjust Privacy Settings

- User Settings > Privacy & Safety
- Weep Me Safe: ON (scans direct messages for explicit content)
- Allow direct messages from server members : OFF
- Use data to customize Discord experience (c.g. DFF OFF
- Allow Discord to track screen reader usage: OFF

3. Control Server Access

- Monitor what servers your child joins
- · Avoid public servers -opt for a private or family-approved ones
- · Turn Explicit Content Filter ON for both DMs and servers

4. Manage Communication

- Block or mute users who exhibit inappropriate behavior
- Teach your child how to report harassment or offensive crient
- Utilize Discord's Block feature on strangers

5. Disable NSFW Content

- Discord automatically restricts NSFW · channels for under-18 acct.
- · Confirm your child's account bithdate is correct
- · Never allow third-party bots that bypass restrictions

6. Use Parental Controls

- Use Qustodio, Bark, Mobicip, Net Nanny
- Those can monitor Time spent on

 shots-depending on device)
